CREDITS AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All students participating in the Central Vermont Big Picture Academy program must complete Rochester High School's Graduation Requirements in order to earn a Rochester High School diploma. These requirements are as follows...

English	4 Credits
Math	3 Credits
Science	3 Credits
Social Studies	4 Credits
The Arts	1 Credit
Physical Education	1.5 Credits
Senior Project	1 Credit
Electives	4.5 Credits
Health	.5 Credit
On Your Own	.5 Credit
Technology	1 Credit (embedded)

Students may earn these credits through a variety of methods such as traditional coursework in the Rochester High School schedule, independent project work, internship (LTI) project work, independent study, on-line coursework, advisory activities, college level coursework, or through some other means that is agreed upon in advance by the student, parent(s), and advisor.

At the close of each semester (mid-year and end-of-year), students must apply for credits by completing the *Credit Application Form* for each credit that they are applying to receive (not necessary for traditional coursework). Credits can be earned in "half credit" increments.

Students should strive to plan and manage their work so they can successfully meet each of the Big Picture Learning Goals each year. Projects should reflect more than one Learning Goal and can earn a student credits in several areas.
